# POWERSCHOOL ONLINE REGISTRATION

***In preparation for the 2021 - 21 school year, we have important information to share with you:***

- ❖ PowerSchool Online Registration is now available for registration for the 2021-22 school year. All parents **MUST** complete the online registration process.
- ❖ You should have received an email from [noreplyregistration@powerschool.com](mailto:noreplyregistration@powerschool.com) containing a link to the registration site and your child's personalized Snap Code that will be used for registration. If you have not received a Snap Code please call the school office.
- ❖ Please collect the following documents and be ready to upload them during the online registration process (or drop them by the school office):
  - For students returning to D2 who **do not have a change in address** - no additional proof of residence is needed
  - For students returning to D2 who **have a change in address or students new to D2:**
    - Parent/Guardian must present a valid, state-issued photo ID with correct address
    - Property Tax bill for the permanent resident, rental lease **AND**
    - Current Electric, water, gas, or landline telephone bill or vehicle registration
  - If your student is currently enrolled using a **Notarized Residency Affidavit (SHARED HOUSING)**, the parent/legal guardian will need to submit an updated Notarized Residency Affidavit for 2021-2022 registration. The Notarized Residency Affidavit (SHARED HOUSING) must be submitted annually. If you are moving in with someone who is renting property, the Residency Affidavit must be signed and notarized by the **Property Owner** to include new residents and children's name.
- ❖ Please complete all steps of the online registration process, including paying instructional fees (\$7).

## ***Important Upcoming Dates***

- ❖ **May 30<sup>th</sup> ... Registration deadline for summer teacher notification**
  - If your student's online registration process is completed by this date, you will receive notification by mail of your child's 2021-22 teacher by June 30<sup>th</sup>.
- ❖ **August 3<sup>rd</sup> ... District 2 Registration Day**
  - You must attend registration **ONLY** if you meet one of the following criteria:
    - You are new to D2 and have not completed the Online Registration process.
    - You need to change transportation information.
    - You need to pay fees, provide proof of residence or have a change in residence.
    - You need to provide a proof-of-residence.
    - You have a change in residence.
